# CANADA Immigration Medical Examination

#### Location:

- Suite 360, 650 West 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue, Vancouver, B.C. V5Z 2M9. (<u>the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor</u>) Oakridge Shopping Centre Mall, Medical/Dental building (South Tower)
- The parking lot entrance is located at Cambie Street and West 42nd Avenue.
- Skytrain: Canada Line, at Cambie/41<sup>st</sup> Station
- Free parking is available for up to 4 hours. The rooftop parking provides convenient access to the clinic.
- The lab exam and X-ray exam offices are located on the second floor of the same building.

#### Fees (Payable in cash, debit card, or Visa/Mastercard)

- Please note the following extra fees:
  - Debit card payments require a 0.76% processing fee.
  - Visa/Mastercard payments require a 2.4% processing fee.
  - Cash: NO FEES (preferred)
- Doctor's exam fee (payable in cash only)
  - Ages up to 59: \$150
  - Age 60 ~ 69: \$170
  - Age 70+: \$190
- Lab and X-ray exam fees (credit card acceptable)
  - < Age 10: Zero
  - Age 11~14: \$95 for X-ray exam
  - Age 15+: \$187 for blood test and X-ray exam
  - Additional fees might be necessary if you have chronic medical conditions, e.g. Hepatitis, HIV, etc. The doctor will inform you.

Generally, it takes 1~1.5 hours to complete the exam, depending on how busy the lab and the X-ray offices are. The case is usually submitted electronically via eMedical to IRCC within 2~3 days unless abnormality shows up and follow-up is necessary.

## AFTER BOOKING IMMIGRATION MEDICAL EXAMINATION

### What to DO when you come for immigration medical examination

- 1. Bring (one of) the proof of identity:
  - Original passport (preferred); not just pictures stored in your phone.
  - Valid Canadian Provincial Driver's license
  - Refugee travel document (if passport is seized by CIC)

2, Bring in letters of invitation from CIC if not doing UFM (Upfront Medical); print out the documents, not just the email in your phone.

3, It is required to come with a parent or a guardian if the applicant is less than 16 years old.

4, No need to bring in your personal photo. The office will take a picture for you.

- **5**, Other instructions:
  - Bring your glasses for eyesight exam. If wearing contact lenses, there is no need to bring other glasses.
  - Bring in all prescribed medications currently taking (no need to bring in vitamins, herbs, Chinese medicine, or other supplements)
  - Bring in any medical records of surgery or major illness if available.
- 6. Please note:
  - You may eat before coming for the exam.
  - Please take your usual medications prior to the exam.
  - Additional blood tests may be required if you have chronic health conditions such as Hepatitis, HIV, etc. The doctor will inform you, and the Lab will charge additional fees for these tests.
  - Fees for the doctor exam, lab exam, and x-ray exam can be paid using cash, debit card, or credit card.

7. Please arrive 10 to 15 minutes before your appointment to complete the necessary paperwork. The entire process may take 1 to 1.5 hours, depending on the lab and X-ray clinic's availability.

8. The office is **Suite 360**, located on **the 3rd floor** of the Medical/Dental Building in the south tower of Oakridge Shopping Centre, 650 W 41st Ave, Vancouver, B.C.

- Mall parking is free for up to four hours, and Suite 360 is easily accessible via rooftop parking.
- The parking lot entrance is located at Cambie Street and West 42nd Avenue.

- You can take the Canada line Skytrain or a bus and get off at the Oakridge/41st station.
- After entering the door of the mall, walk the stairs by Crate and Barrel and go to the 3rd floor. Suite 360 is just to your right.
- You can use the mall-provided golf cart, parked near Crate and Barrel, to travel to the 3rd floor free of charge.
- The Lab and X-ray offices are located on the 2nd floor of the same building.
